

### MEDICAL DECLARATION

1. I hereby declare that I have never suffered from any medical condition which may create or lead to a dangerous situation in flight, especially blackouts of any cause (epilepsy, severe head injury, recurrent fainting or giddiness, high blood pressure, angina, coronary artery disease, insulin dependent diabetes etc) or from any other disability which would be likely to result in the flying of a glider by me being a source of danger to myself or others.
2. I am able (with glasses if necessary) to read a normal car number plate at a distance of 25 yards. (If you normally wear glasses, you should always carry a readily available spare pair.)
3. I am not without hand or foot and do not suffer from any defect in movement or control or muscular power of either arm or leg.
4. I understand that minor illnesses, inoculations, drugs and the donation of blood may make me temporarily unfit to fly and I undertake not to fly unless I am in a normal state of health.
5. I understand that it is my responsibility to inform the club if any change occurs which affects this declaration.
